Indian Parliament



- Parliament is the supreme legislative body of India. The Indian Parliament comprises of the President and the two Houses - Rajya Sabha (Council of States) and Lok Sabha (House of the People)
- The Lok Sabha comprises of a total of 545 seats.
- Elections will be conducted by the Election Commission to fill 543 seats.
- The remaining two seats are filled by nomination of representatives of the Anglo-Indian Community
- Out of the elective seats, 79 are reserved for SC and 41 for ST.

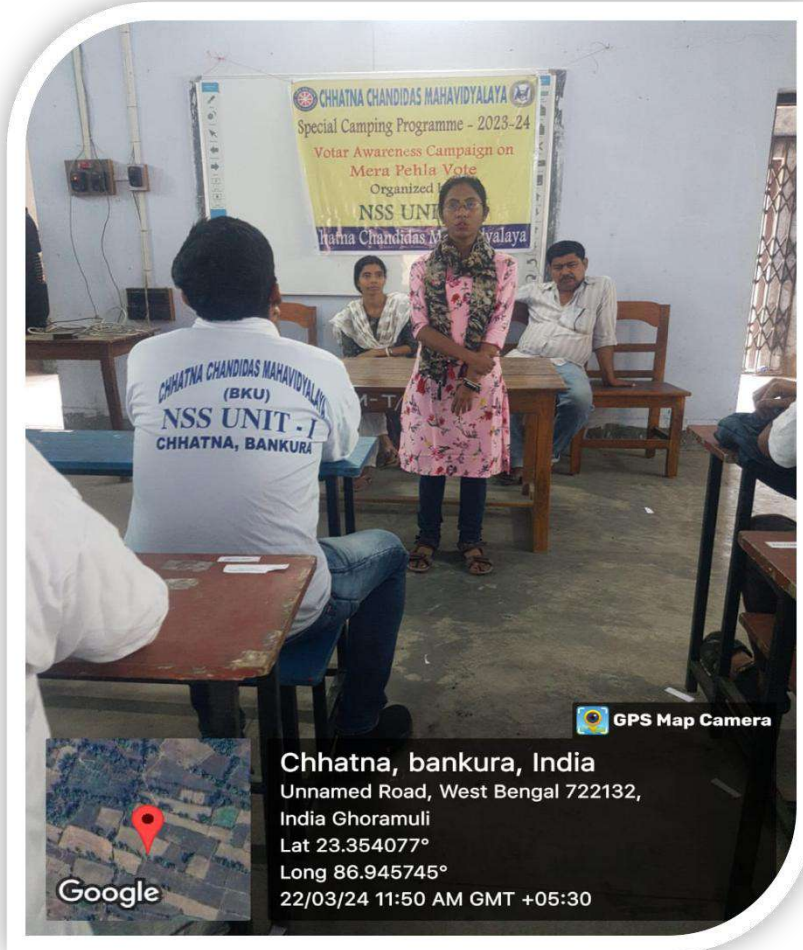

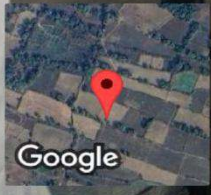

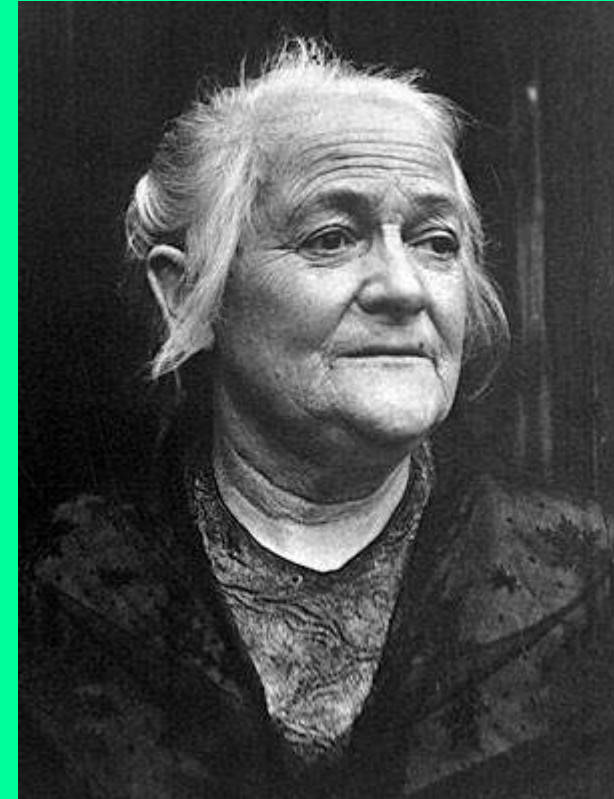

ভারতের সংবিধানের প্রস্তাবনা

“আমরা, ভারতের জনগণ, সত্যনিষ্ঠার সঙ্গে সংকল্প করে ভারতকে একটি সার্বভৌম সমাজতান্ত্রিক ধর্মনিরপেক্ষ সাধারণতন্ত্র (SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC) রূপে গড়ে তুলতে এবং দেশের সকল নাগরিক যাতে সামাজিক, অর্থনৈতিক ও রাজনৈতিক ন্যায়বিচার (JUSTICE); চিন্তা, মতপ্রকাশ, বিশ্বাস, ধর্ম ও উপাসনার স্বাধীনতা (LIBERTY); মর্যাদা ও সুযোগসুবিধার ক্ষেত্রে সাম্য (EQUALITY) ভোগ করতে পারে এবং তাদের সকলের মধ্যে ব্যক্তিমর্যাদা, জাতিগত ঐক্য ও সংহতি (Unity and Integrity of the Nation)-র নিশ্চয়তা সাধন করার উদ্দেশ্যে ভ্রাতৃত্ববোধ (FRATERNITY)-এর প্রসারকল্পে, আজ 1949 সালের 26 নভেম্বর আমাদের গণপরিষদে এই সংবিধান গ্রহণ ও বিধিবদ্ধ করছি এবং নিজেদের অর্পণ করছি”

প্রস্তাবনায় উল্লিখিত ‘আমরা, ভারতের জনগণ...’ (We, the people of India) বলতে বোঝানো হয়েছে যে, ভারতের সংবিধান রচনার আইনগত এবং নৈতিক ভিত্তি হল ভারতবর্ষের জনগণ। এই অর্থে জনগণই হল দেশের সংবিধানের মূল উৎস ও চরম সার্বভৌম ক্ষমতার অধিকারী।

মৌলিক অধিকার

মৌলিক অধিকারের সংজ্ঞা

ভারতীয় সংবিধানের তৃতীয় অংশের [Part-III] অন্তর্গত 12-35 নং ধারায় মৌলিক অধিকার সম্পর্কে বিস্তারিত আলোচনা করা আছে। সাধারণভাবে নাগরিকদের অধিকারসমূহের মধ্যে যেগুলি ব্যক্তিত্ব বিকাশের পক্ষে একান্ত অপরিহার্য সেগুলিকেই মৌলিক অধিকার বা **Fundamental Rights** বলা যায়। প্রকৃতপক্ষে, মৌলিক অধিকার হল সমাজ কর্তৃক স্বীকৃত ও রাষ্ট্র কর্তৃক বাস্তবায়িত দাবি। কিন্তু মৌলিক অধিকারগুলি ব্যক্তিসত্তার পরিপূর্ণ বিকাশের জন্য অপরিহার্য বলে বিবেচিত হলেও এই অধিকারগুলির কোনোটিই সীমাহীন বা অবাধ নয়। কোনো ক্ষেত্রে সংবিধান নিজে এবং কিছু ক্ষেত্রে পার্লামেন্টও এই অধিকারগুলির ওপর বাধানিষেধ আরোপ করতে সক্ষম।

ভারতীয় সংবিধানে মোট ৬টি মৌলিক অধিকার বর্ণিত রয়েছে। এই অধিকারগুলি হল—সাম্যের অধিকার, স্বাধীনতার অধিকার, শোষণের বিরুদ্ধে অধিকার, ধর্মীয় স্বাধীনতার অধিকার, সংস্কৃতি ও শিক্ষাবিষয়ক অধিকার এবং সাংবিধানিক প্রতিবিধানের অধিকার।

Fundamental Rights - মৌলিক অধিকার

- 1) সমান অধিকার (14 - 18)
- 2) স্বাধীনতার অধিকার (19 - 22)
- 3) শোষণের বিরুদ্ধে অধিকার (23 - 24)
- 4) ধর্মীয় স্বাধীনতার অধিকার (25 - 28)
- 5) সংস্কৃতি ও শিক্ষার অধিকার (29 - 30)
- 6) সাংবিধানিক উপচারের অধিকার বা শাসনতান্ত্রিক প্রতিবিধানের অধিকার (32 - 35)

- **Article 42** seeks to ensure humane work conditions and provide for **maternity relief**. It states that “The State shall make provision for securing just and humane conditions of work and for maternity relief”

Ever since he established a community in Phoenix (now an Indian township northwest of central Durban in South Africa), he made cleaning of the campus a common activity for everyone. Cleaning of the toilets, which was considered to be the dirtiest of jobs was voluntarily taken up by Gandhiji himself until it became a natural part of the whole process of sanitation.
